Data Analysis

Of the 136 COHN(C) scheduled to renew their COHN(C) this year.

- 100 gave consent to share their contact details with COHNA-ACIIST Association
- 59 of the 100 are from Ontario or 60% COHN(C) who can re-certify this year are from Ontario

This is a very influencing number in helping the COHN(C) certification examination reach it’s target of 100 candidates.
